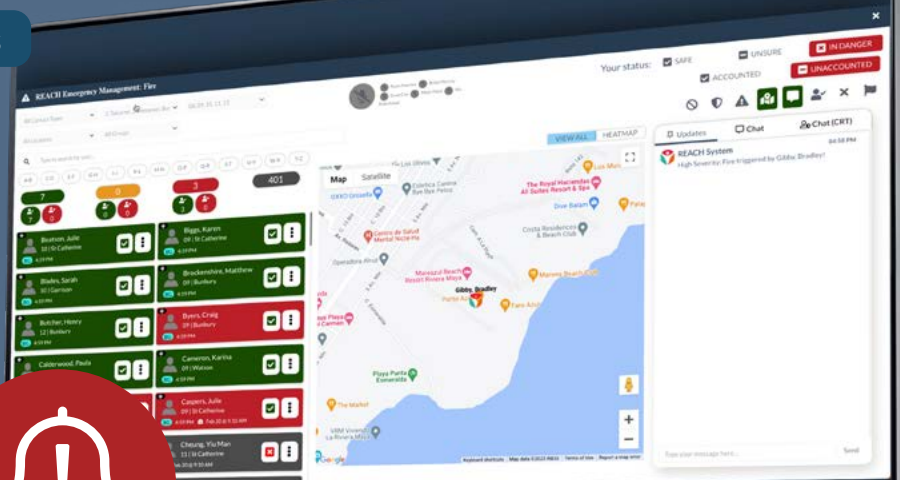

## What is ATLS?



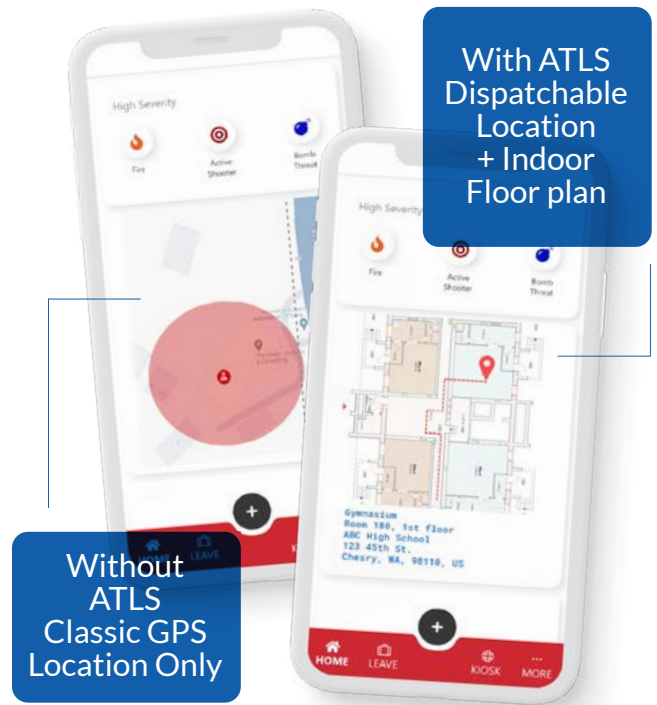
A location service with indoor location intelligence visualized on an indoor floor plan.
